



EASILY RECOGNISED BY ITS COAT OF REDDISH-ORANGE WITH DARK STRIPES, THE TIGER IS THE LARGEST WILD CAT IN THE WORLD. IN 1973, THE GOVERNMENT DECLARED THE TIGER INDIA'S NATIONAL ANIMAL, BANNED HUNTING AND SET UP CONSERVATION SCHEME CALLED PROJECT TIGER.

TIGER RESERVES OF INDIA WERE ESTABLISHED IN 1973-74 AND ARE GOVERNED BY PROJECT TIGER, WORKING UNDER THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE NATIONAL TIGER CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AND THERE ARE CURRENTLY 53 TIGER RESERVES IN INDIA.

AS TOP PREDATORS, WILD TIGERS PLAY AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN MAINTAINING THE HARMONY OF THE ECOSYSTEM. BY PREYING ON HERBIVOURS, TIGERS HELP TO KEEP THE BALANCE BETWEEN THE PREY ANIMALS AND THE FOREST VEGETATION WHICH THEY FEED UPON.

A HEALTHY TIGER POPULATION LIVES IN LARGE FOR EST 6- WHICH ARE NOTHING BOT THE NATIONAL SINKS OF CARBON. THE MORE TIGERS WE CAN SAVE ITHE MORE HEALTHIER RESERVES WE HAVE, LARGER IS OUR NATIONAL CARBON SINKS. A TIGER SHOULD THEREFORE BE ENTITLED TO CARBON CREDITS IN THE FORM OF PROTECTION.

THEME: CONSERVATION OF TIGERS

The following is the foresent approach to tiger conservation globally and its imperative 1. Strengthening the source population of tiger and its prey in tiger suserves, for texted areas and tiger bearing forests that involves protection / anti-fracking sperations / intelligence networking, strengthening of infrastructure within tigen neverves, creation of inviolate space through relocation, capacity lowlding of frontlines staff / local people and office (including strengthening of training centers). 2. Managing the "source-rink dynamics" by nestoring habitat connectivity. This involves actively providing incentives to local people for the exosystem services / corridor values provided by them by not degrading the forest. Also granting them to local people for taking up plantations and protecting natural root stocks besides preventing free grazing, encouraging stall feeding of cattle and fostering narketing of dairy products, providing subsidized gas connection to local people for reducing their dependence on forest towards full wood collection. 3. Implementing smart practices with other India Tiger Action Clan 2012-2022 that well cater to concerns of tigers dwelling in the landscape and help service man-tiger conflicts in the sectors such as forestry, agriculture, townism, fisheries, road/rail transport, industry, mining, thermal power plants, irrigation projects, temple townism and communication projects inside the landscape. All the above efforts seem to have produced promising results by doubling of the Indian tiger population by 2022 as per the Indian government declariation. Although scientists debate it but India's Tiger iconservation seems to be a massive success story where most other nations have failed in increasing their tizer population considerably. A major issue though, is since tigers aren't able to mean freely especially in small restricted reserve areas and they start breeding within relatives. Passing over of policious new gener and thereby maintaining a high genetic variations is mandatory for healthy population, lest we end up with weak ligers in massive goos!
